Acknowledging its supreme and final authority above all others <sup>6</sup> Striving for the advancement of this church in biblically-rooted knowledge, holiness & comfort<sup>7</sup>

Refusing to be led astray by unbiblical philosophies, false teachers, manmade traditions and even our own hearts<sup>8</sup>

## 2. To promote and protect the unity of the church by:

Confessing and defending the doctrines as revealed in the Bible 10

Walking together in a way that honors God 11

Speaking the truth in love in ways that are edifying and encouraging<sup>12</sup>

Seeking reconciliation by humbly repenting of sins and freely offering forgiveness<sup>13</sup>

Serving and providing care for one another as members of one body in Christ<sup>14</sup>

Submitting to the leaders with joy who have been granted authority by Christ through the church, recognizing these men must give an account.<sup>15</sup>

Working together in accordance with this Covenant, our Church Constitution and our Confessions, <sup>16</sup> Watching over one another and as disciples of Christ, humbly receive and give rebuke as occasion requires, <sup>17</sup>

Participating in and accepting the discipline of the church concerning doctrine and conduct, <sup>18</sup>

#### 3. To take part in building up the church by:

Giving our time and money cheerfully and faithfully to the ministries of the church, 19

Serving the church using our spiritual gifts to build others up,<sup>20</sup>

Praying for the church as a whole and for its members,<sup>21</sup>

Participating in the life of the church by actively engaging in worship, fellowship and ministry faithfully, unless providentially hindered, <sup>22</sup>

Giving the church a sacred pre-eminence over all institutions of human origin, <sup>23</sup>

Observing the ordinances of Baptism and the Lord's Supper that Christ has given to the church,<sup>24</sup>

Committed stewardship of our family in God honoring ways, 25

Engaging in family worship and private devotion, <sup>26</sup>

Loving and training those under our care in the fear of the Lord, 27

#### 4. To bear witness for Christ and His Kingdom by:

*Unashamedly seeking the salvation of others through the proclamation of the gospel throughout the nations*, <sup>28</sup>

Aiding the persecuted, poor, vulnerable and suffering,<sup>29</sup>

Living with love, humility, justice, mercy, holiness, and peace wherever we go,<sup>30</sup>

Promising to unite as soon as possible with another church of like faith and commitment to God's Word if we move from this place.<sup>31</sup>
